## 1 Prague

Prague is the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic. This beautiful city is situated on the River Vltava in central Bohemia. Prague has always been the political, cultural, and economic centre of the Czech state. For many decades during the Gothic and Renaissance eras, Prague was the seat of two Holy Roman Emperors and was also the capital of the Holy Roman Empire. Today, the city proper is home to more than 1.2 million people, while its metropolitan area is estimated to have a population of over 1.9 million. The president, government and parliament residences are located here. Prague is the centre of academic and vocational education, the seat of the Academy of Sciences and of a number of other research and scientific institutes.

It is a significant European cultural centre which includes a number of theatres, museums, galleries and exhibition halls. It is a European crossroad. Prague contains an extremely large number of significant architectural buildings dating from all periods. The historic town centre, which extends over an area of 866 ha, has been included in the UNESCO World Cultural And Nature Heritage List since 1992. Nicknames for Prague have included "the mother of cities" (Praga mater urbium, or "Praha matka měst" in Czech), "city of a hundred towers" and "the golden city"

### Main sights

Prague is one of the most popular Europe's (and the world's) tourist destinations. It contains pristine and varied collections of architecture, from Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque to Art Nouveau, Cubist, Neo-Classical and ultra-modern.

- The vaulted gothic Old New Synagogue of 1270

- Prague Castle (the largest castle in the world) with its St. Vitus Cathedral
- Vyšehrad castle & cemetery where many famous Czechs are buried including the composers Antonín Dvořák & Bedřich Smetana.
- Josefov (the old Jewish quarter) with Old Jewish Cemetery and Old New Synagogue
- Jan Žižka equestrian statue in Vítkov Park, Žižkov - Prague 3.
- Museum of Decorative Arts in Prague - huge collections of glass, furniture, textile, toys, Art Nouveau, Cubism, Art Deco, and so on.
- The museum of Heydrich assassination in the crypt of the Church of Saints Cyril and Methodius
- National Museum
- Petřín observation tower on Petřín hill, which resembles the Eiffel Tower
- Žižkov Television Tower with observation deck
- The New Jewish Cemetery in Olšany, location of Franz Kafka's grave - Prague 3.
- The Mucha Museum, showcasing the Art Nouveau works of Alfons Mucha
- Places connected to writers living in the city, such as Franz Kafka (One popular destination is the Franz Kafka museum, also his grave at the Jewish cemetery near the metro station Želivského)
- The Prague Zoo elected as the 7th best Zoo in the world by Forbes magazine
- Anděl (neighbourhood) which is probably the busiest part of the city with a super modern shopping mall and architecture

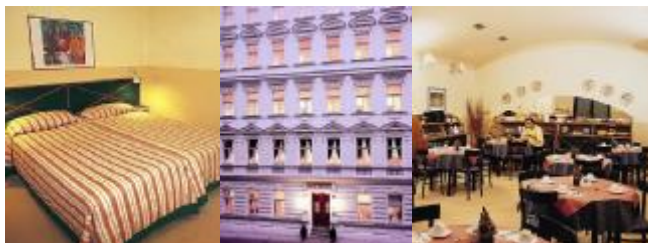

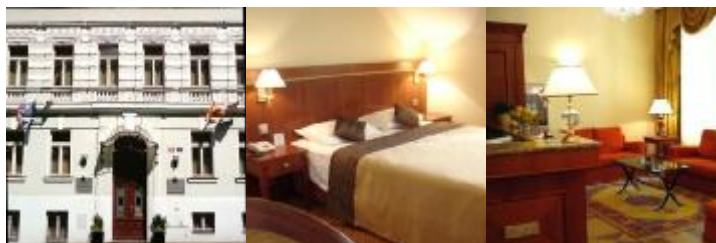

## 2 Carlsbad Region

### 2.1 Karlovy Vary

Karlovy Vary (Carlsbad) is a spa city situated in western Bohemia, Czech Republic, on the confluence of the rivers Ohře and Teplá, approximately 130 km (80.78 miles) west of Prague. It is named after King of Bohemia and Holy Roman Emperor Charles IV, who founded the city in 1370. It is historically famous for its hot springs (13 main springs, about 300 smaller springs, and the warm-water Teplá River). In the 19th century, it became a popular tourist destination, especially for international celebrities visiting for spa treatment. The city is also known for Karlovy Vary International Film Festival, popular Czech liqueur Karlovarská Becherovka, manufacturer Moser Glass.

## 2.2 Mariánské Lázně

Mariánské Lázně is a spa town in the Carlsbad Region of the Czech Republic. The town, surrounded by green mountains, is an exquisite mosaic of parks and noble houses. Most of its buildings come from the town's Golden Era in the second half of the 19th century, when many celebrities and top European rulers came to enjoy the curative carbon dioxide springs.

## 2.3 Františkovy Lázně

Františkovy Lázně is world renowned as a spa. The salutary effects of the springs were known from the 15th century on. In the year 1793, the town was officially founded under the name Kaiser Franzensdorf (Emperor Francis II's village) and later renamed to Franzensbad, under which name it became a famous spa. It was the first peat pulp bath in the world and operated 24 mineral springs, 12 of which are still in operation.

## 3 SOUTH MORAVIAN REGION, region of many colours and scents

We can say that The Southern Moravia region represents the crossroads of Europe. It is located in the southeast part of the Czech Republic, along the border with Austria and Slovakia and it is the fourth largest district in Czech Republic with a territory of 7.195 km<sup>2</sup>. If somebody says South Moravia, one of the first things you think of is wine, vineyards, wine-vaults, vintage and other aspects of this everlasting theme. The region has a rich folklore tradition. In addition to historic sights and natural beauty, some protected by UNESCO, visitors are attracted by the cordiality and hospitality of its inhabitants, who are proud of living in Southern Moravia.

### 3.1 Regions of Southern Moravia

#### 3.1.1 Brno and the surrounding areas

The capital of the region is Brno, the trade fair centre of Central Europe, and seat of many important institutions, including several of the highest state offices and foreign embassies, etc. Brno has a population of 380,000. The district is an important transport junction in the Czech Republic, and also for the whole of Europe. A dense network of motorway communications is made up partly of the D1 (Prague-Brno-Vyškov) and D2 (Brno-Bratislava) motorways, and the Brno-Tuřany International Airport has regular Brno-London flights. As a city accustomed to welcoming foreign guests, Brno offers adequate infrastructure such as hotel capacity and accompanying tourism services, including numerous cultural, social and sports activities.

#### 3.1.2 Pálava and the Lednice-Valtice area

This region of riparian forests, vineyards, and fertile fields in the southernmost tip of Moravia is famous for a rich history, folklore traditions, and numerous architectural landmarks. Two local sites are even inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List: the Lednice-Valtice cultural area and the Pálava Biosphere Reserve. In the Lednice-Valtice area are two well built chateaux – a neo-gothic chateau in Lednice and baroque residence in Valtice – with beautiful gardens and parks full of romantic vistas and interesting smaller buildings.

#### 3.1.3 The Moravian Karst and the surrounding areas

This beautiful area is located north of Brno and it is one of the most ecologically pure territories in the Czech Republic. The area boasts all the prerequisites for the development of tourism and recreation. The pleasant and healthy natural environment is ideal for stays and sport in open natural surroundings, including hiking, cross-country skiing, cycling, and horseback riding. In addition to natural beauty this region is endowed with a rich history and countless architectural landmarks. The Svitava River flows through the centre of the area, while the underground Punkva River courses its way through the territory of the Moravian Karst.

#### 3.1.4 The Znojmo area and Podyjí

The Znojmo area and Podyjí is a region full of history, fertile vineyards, magical nature, and numerous historical landmarks. The centre of the region is the town of Znojmo, the second largest town in the South Moravia Region as well as the centre of this famous wine-making region. Znojmo has not only a Roman rotunda with frescos portraying the Přemysl dynasty, but also a mysterious thirty kilometre long labyrinth of corridors and cellars and beautiful Znojmo Castle. Adding to the area's attractiveness is Podyjí, one of the four Czech national parks situated along the Dyje River. During the summer its Vranov Reservoir and other recreational bodies of water are highly popular with tourists. The region is also well-known for exceptional wine. Scores of connoisseurs are drawn each year, not only by the wide selection of wine tourism programmes, but by additional cultural and social events such as the Znojmo Harvest.

#### 3.1.5 Moravian Slovakia

Located on the southeast tip of the Czech Republic on the border with Austria and Slovakia, the region of Moravian Slovakia is an area with a rich past documented by priceless archaeological finds, rare architectural landmarks of both spiritual and secular life, preserved folk architecture, and above all folklore and folk culture traditions. The natural border region is formed by the deep deciduous Žďánice Forest and the Chřiby Mountain range on the north and the ridge of the White Carpathians to the south. The Hodonín region is also a celebrated wine-making area.

## 4 BRATISLAVA

She was crowned Queen of Hungary in St. Martin's cathedral in Pressburg, just like the 10 other kings and 8 royal partners over the course of 300 years when Pressburg was in fact the capital of the Kingdom of Hungary. The rich mix of cultures and nations not only left its mark in the language spoken here, but also in the customs, cuisine and lifestyle.

### Main sights

Bratislava is justly considered as the city of music. In the past, the giants of music like Mozart, Haydn, Beethoven, Rubinstein, and Hummel acted here. The present ballet and opera of the Slovak National Theatre are world-known by their classical performances and brought up the opera stars like Peter Dvorský, Lucia Popp or Edita Gruber.

The historical buildings of the opera of the Slovak National Theatre or the Slovak Philharmonic Orchestra – Reduta are often used for the organization of many cultural and social events.

Besides music and opera in Bratislava are situated more than 20 galleries with permanent expositions of the ancient and modern art and many interesting temporary exhibitions. Among the cultural attractions can be seen the original „Passage“ - the similar one cannot be found anywhere in the world.

Annually in Bratislava are held many cultural events. Among them the best-known are Bratislava Music Festival (BHS) in September and Bratislava Jazz Days (BJD) in October.

Since 1999, very popular are the events held in exteriors. One of the most visited is Bratislava Coronation Ceremony. The greatest event is still the magnificent celebration of New Year (New Year's Eve Party), having the nickname „Welcome to Partyslava“.

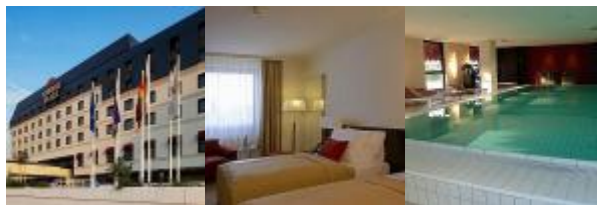

## 5 VIENNA

Vienna is the capital of the Republic of Austria and also one of the nine states of Austria. Vienna is Austria's primary city, with a population of about 1.7 million (2.3 million within the urban area), and is by far the largest city in Austria, as well as its cultural, economic, and political centre. It is the 10th largest city by population in the European Union. Vienna is host to many major international organizations such as the United Nations and OPEC. In 2001, the city centre was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

#### Main sights

Major tourist attractions include the imperial palaces of the Hofburg and Schönbrunn (also home to the world's oldest zoo, Tiergarten Schönbrunn) and the Riesenrad in the Prater. Cultural highlights include the Burgtheater, the Wiener Staatsoper, the Lipizzaner horses at the spanische Hofreitschule and the Vienna Boys' Choir, as well as excursions to Vienna's Heuriger districts. There are also more than 100 art museums, which together attract over eight million visitors per year. The most popular ones are Albertina, Belvedere, Leopold Museum in the Museumsquartier, KunstHausWien, BA-CA Kunstforum, the twin Kunsthistorisches Museum and Naturhistorisches Museum, and the Technisches Museum Wien. There are many popular sites associated with composers who lived in Vienna including Beethoven's various residences and grave at Zentralfriedhof (Central Cemetery) which is the largest cemetery in Vienna and the burial site of many famous people. Mozart has a memorial grave at the Habsburg gardens and at St. Marx cemetery (where his grave was lost). Vienna's many churches also draw large crowds, the most famous of which are St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Deutschordenskirche, the Jesuitenkirche, the Karlskirche, the Peterskirche, Maria am Gestade, the Minoritenkirche, the Ruprechtskirche, the Schottenkirche and the Votivkirche. Modern attractions include the Hundertwasserhaus, the United Nations headquarters and the view from the Donauturm.

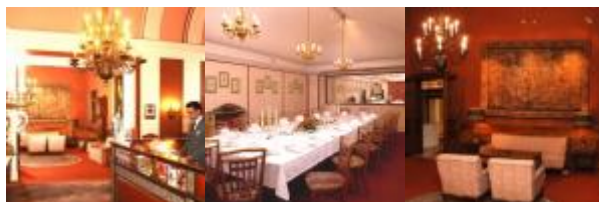

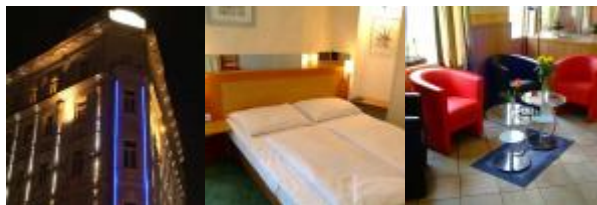

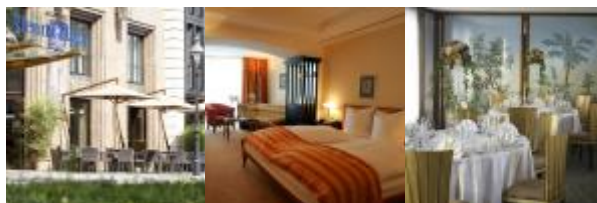

## 6 BUDAPEST

Budapest is the capital of Hungary. As the largest city of Hungary, it serves as the country's principal political, cultural, commercial, industrial, and transportation centre and is considered an important hub in Central Europe. Budapest became a single city occupying both banks of the river Danube with a unification on 17 November 1873 of right-bank Buda and Óbuda with left-bank Pest. Budapest is the city with the biggest Jewish population in Europe.

Widely regarded as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, its extensive World Heritage Site includes the banks of the Danube, the Buda Castle Quarter, Andrassy Avenue, Heroes' Square and the Millennium Underground Railway, the second oldest in the world. Other highlights include a total of 80 geothermal springs, the world's largest thermal water cave system, second largest synagogue, and third largest Parliament building. The collections of the Natural History Museum and the Museum of Fine Arts are also significant.

### Main sights

The neo-Gothic Parliament, containing amongst other things the Hungarian Crown Jewels. Saint Stephen's Basilica, where the Holy Right Hand of the founder of Hungary, King Saint Stephen is on display. The Hungarian cuisine and café culture: for example, Gerbeaud Café, and the Százéves, Biarritz, Fortuna, Alabárdos, Arany Szarvas, Kárpátia and the world famous Mátyás Pince Restaurants. There are Roman remains at the Aquincum Museum, and historic furniture at the Nagytétény Castle Museum.

The Castle Hill, the River Danube embankments and the whole of Andrassy út have been officially recognized as UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Castle Hill and the Castle District; there are three churches here, six museums, and a host of interesting buildings, streets and squares. The former Royal Palace is one of the symbols of Hungary – and has been the scene of battles and wars ever since the thirteenth century. Nowadays it houses two impressive museums and the National Széchenyi Library. The nearby Sándor Palace contains the offices and official residence of the President of Hungary. The seven-hundred year-old Matthias Church is one of the jewels of Budapest. Next to it is an equestrian statue of the first king of Hungary, King Saint Stephen, and behind that is the Fisherman's Bastion, from where opens out a panoramic view of the whole city. Statues of the Turul, the mythical guardian bird of Hungary, can be found in both the Castle District and the Twelfth District.

In Pest, arguably the most important sight is Andrassy út. As far as Kodály Körönd and Oktogon both sides are lined with large shops and flats built close together. Between there and Heroes' Square the houses are detached and altogether grander. Heroes' Square is dominated by the Millenary Monument, with the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in front. To the sides are the Museum of Fine Arts and the Palace of Arts, and behind City Park opens out, with Vajdahunyad Castle. One of the jewels of Andrassy út is the Hungarian State Opera House. Statue Park, a theme park with striking statues of the Communist era, is located just outside the main city and is accessible by public transport.

The city is home to the largest synagogue in Europe (Dohány Street Synagogue), the largest medicinal bath in Europe (Széchenyi Medicinal Bath) and the third largest Parliament building in the world, once the largest in the world. The third largest church in Europe (Esztergom Basilica) and the second largest Baroque castle in the world (Gödöllő) are in the vicinity.

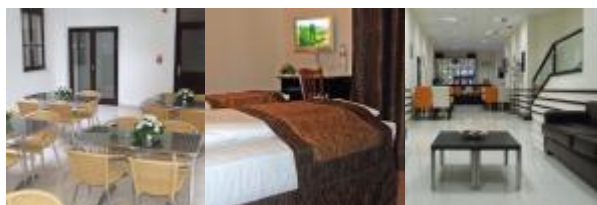

## 7 GENERAL CONDITIONS

Fulfilment of the following general conditions is the necessary presumption for cooperation with NATOUR. In case of a special situation it is possible after consultation with a business partner to modify the conditions or part of them. Natour is a private Travel Agency, established 1990 under the Czech law order, stated in the trade register, member of the Association of Travel Agencies of Czech Republic ACK and IATA.

### 1. CONTACT CONDITIONS AND CHANGES OF AGREED SERVICES:

Obligatory agreement between Natour and foreign business partner is coming into being at the moment when agreement about kind, quality, extent and terms of demanding services is made together with the confirmation of their prices by foreign business partner. This agreement has to be realized in the written form, i. e. that the orders and their obligatory receivings have to be made by email or fax. The demands for the changes of the services, which are known in advance, have to be made by a written form as with a sufficient time reserve.

### 2. CONSEQUENCES IN CASE OF THE CHANGES IN FULFILMENT OF SERVICES:

Natour is obliged to fulfil the agreed services. This obligation could be eliminated by force majeure only. Business partner can cancel or change the agreed services with the consequences mentioned in number 4.

### 3. COMPENSATION OF FULLFILMENT:

In case that Natour is not exceptionally able to fulfil the agreed services, is obliged to discuss this matter with the business partner or its representative and to arrange the reserve services which are equivalent to the agreed services. Natour is paying all eventual increased expences caused by the above situation. In case that the reserve fulfilment of the services is not in order with the agreed services, Natour is obliged to provide business partner with reduction compensation or refundation of the services.

### 4. CANCELLATION CONDITIONS

In case that business partner entirely or partially cancels agreed services, he is obliged to settle the charges stated below to Natour:

### 5. PAYMENT AND PRICE CONDITION:

The prices quoted by Natour are net for individuals and groups. Business partner is obliged to pay 50% from the total price not later than 30 days before the arrival of the clients. The rest of the total price is due not later than before the arrival of the clients. In case that order is sent to Natour later than 30 days before arrival, business partner is obliged to pay 100% of the total price immediately after the agreement of services and its price.

NATOUR IS RECEIVING THE PAYMENT:

- by bank transfer or credit card with bank charges for payer
- by traveller cheques issued to profit of Natour
- in cash

Banking cheques are not accepted. Business partner is obliged to send the copy of bank transfer without delay to Natour. In case that business partner does not observe conditions determined in this part, Natour is allowed to cancel the contract. In this situation business partner has no right for recompensation. All overpayments are considered as a deposit for the following actions.

### 6. SOLVING OF THE CONTENTIONS:

All the contentions between Natour and business partner will be solved by a personal discussion. In case disagreement the trade law court of Czech Republic is competent to solve these contentions of.

7. BUSINESS PARTNER IS OBLIGED TO CONFIRM A RECEIVING OF ALL ABOVE CONDITIONS NOT LATER THAN WITH HIS FIRST ORDER OF SERVICES IN CIVIL YEAR.
